The Afternoon Team has played three games so far, winning two and drawing one. The team is currently in the joint top of their league and are in the semi-finals of the challenge cup.

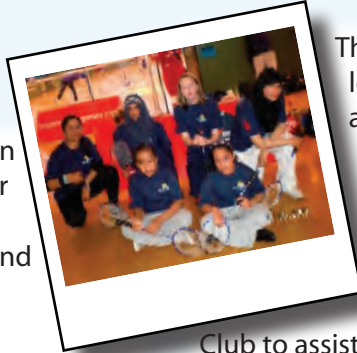
