## **Fernhead Rovers Update...**

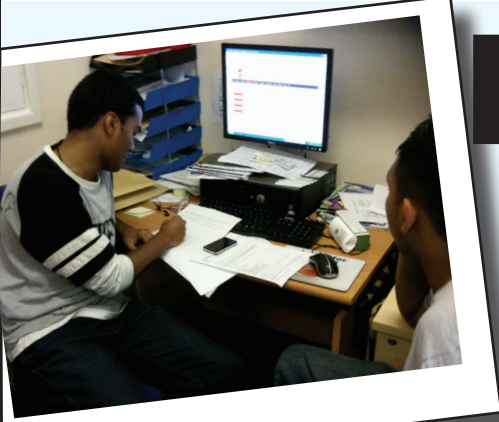
